

The TIN Arts Young People's Support Fund has been created to enable access for all to TIN Arts' Bounce dance classes.

TIN Arts are creating this fund as a response to the increased number of financial barriers currently facing young people and their families including the cost-of-living crisis. Currently the fund is only available to those who are already registered and are attending Bounce classes, although we are exploring ways of opening it to others in the future.

Funding to reduce or remove class fees will be awarded each term to individuals on a case-by-case basis. Individuals can apply to the fund more than once, but priority will be given to those applying for the first time. In exceptional cases, the fund may provide additional support to young people attending Bounce classes, for example by paying for transport or clothing or by funding participation in events or competitions.

By applying for funding in support of class fees, young people and their families commit to attending Bounce classes regularly.
