Or visit a local cafe's or shops nearby. You can leave and return to IncludFEST whenever you need to.

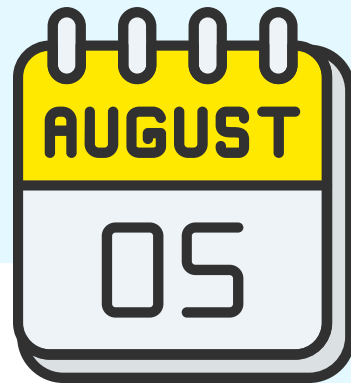

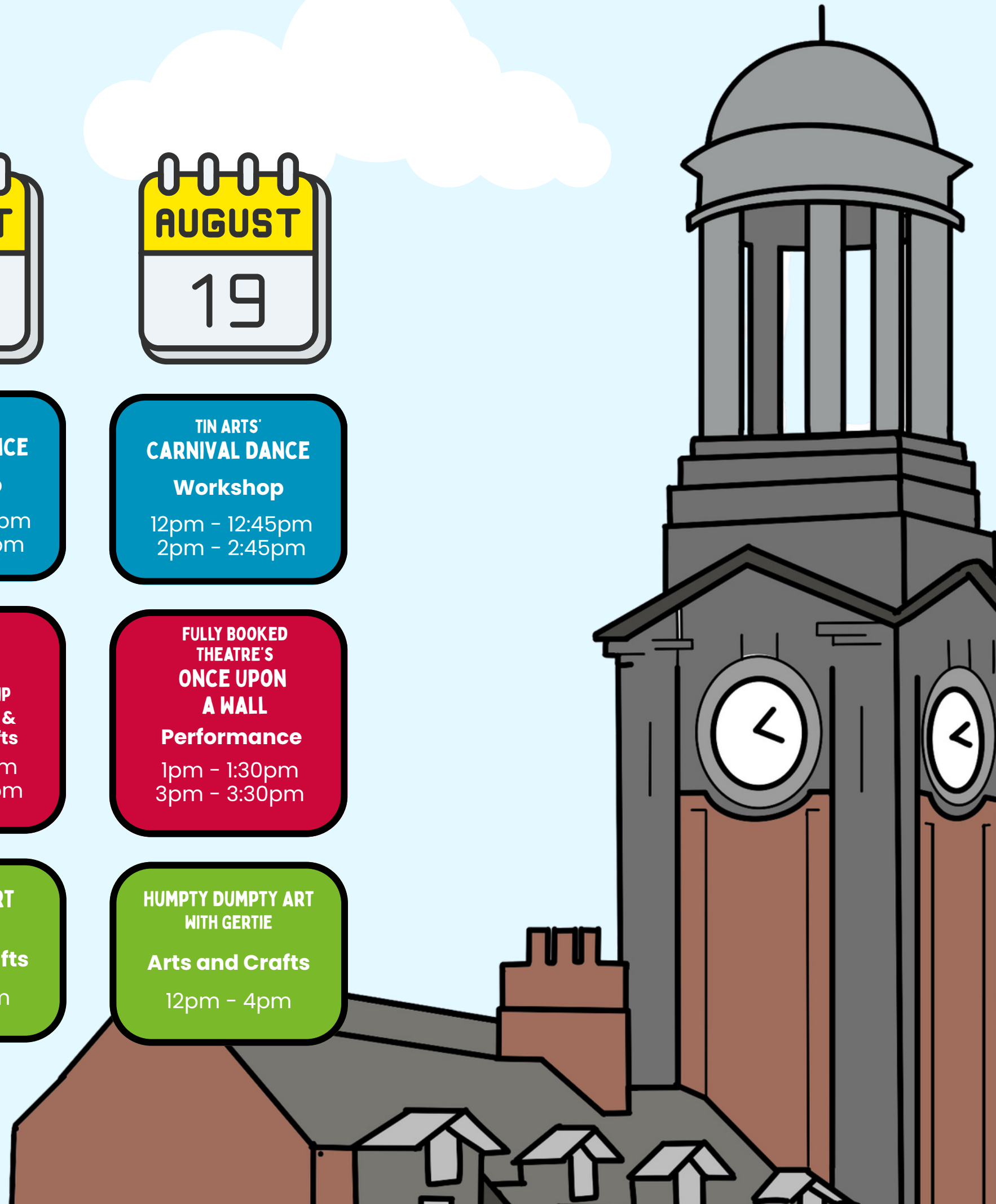

At the IncludFEST info point you can find more information about the festival. You will find it at the bandstand. This is also where you will find the lost children point.



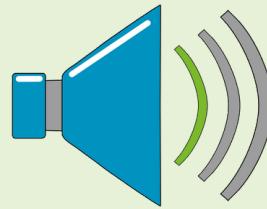
British Sign Language

Amplified Music

Wheelchair Accessibility

IncludFEST is a wheelchair accessible event. The paths in Victoria Jubilee Park are well maintained. There are some gentle slopes.

The IncludFEST team are wearing hi vis jackets or lanyards. They can answer any questions you have and help you find activities.



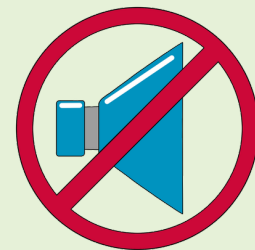
Toilets

There is an accessible toilet onsite. The closest available changing places facility is at Spennymoor Leisure Centre, High St, Spennymoor DL16 6DB. (8 minute walk)

There are lots of quiet spaces in the park away from the IncludFEST activities.



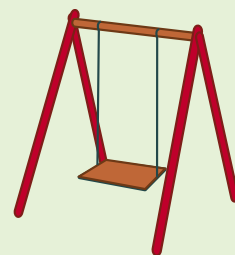
Ear Defenders

GETTING TO INCLUDFEST BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

By bus:

The nearest bus stop to Victoria Jubilee Park is on Greenways Estate, Spennymoor.

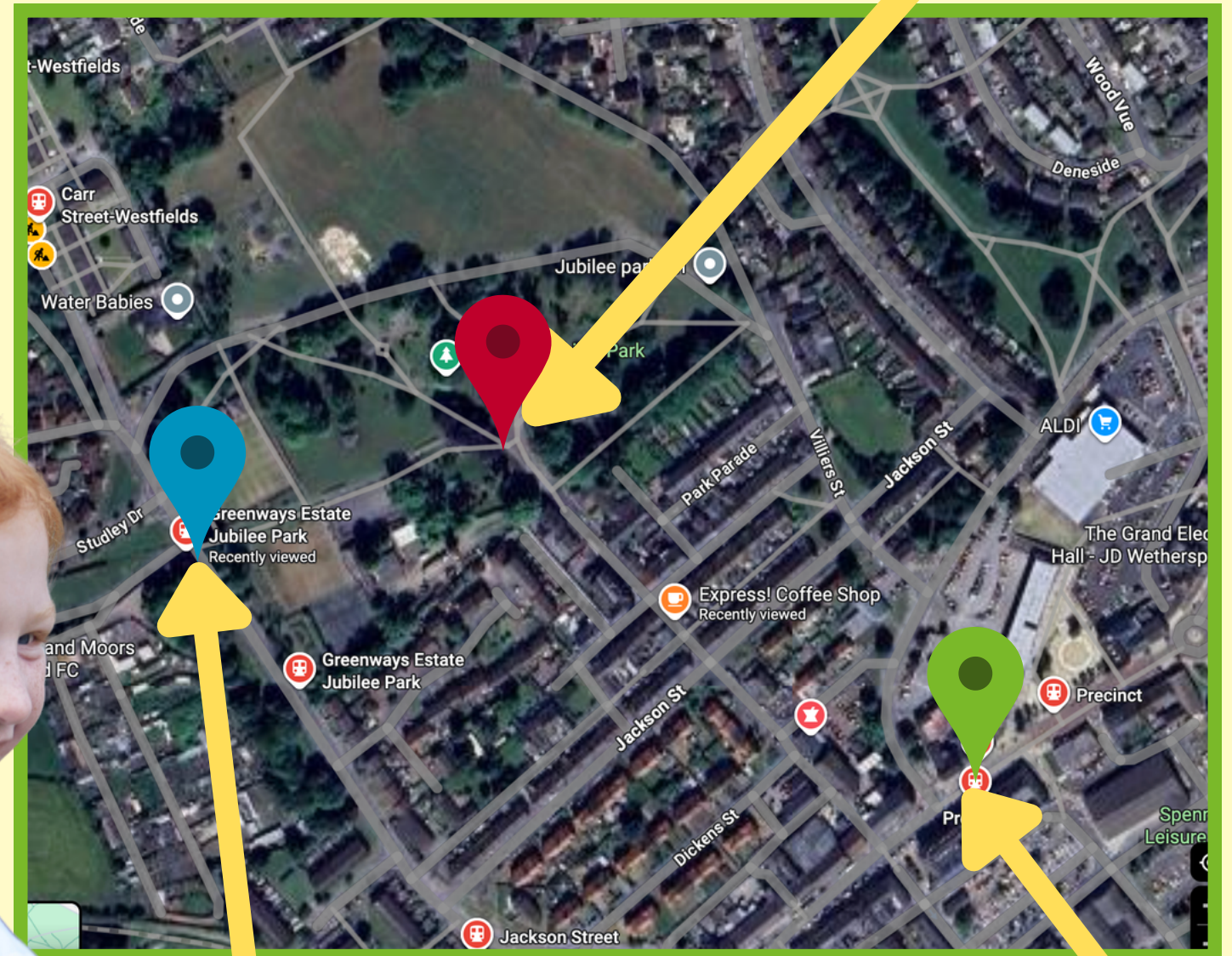
There is also a bus stop on High Street, Spennymoor, a 6 minute walk from the park. Regular Arriva and Go North East buses serve Spennymoor from Durham, Bishop Auckland, Ferryhill, Newton Aycliffe and other nearby towns.

You can use [Google Maps](#), [Arriva](#) or [Go North East](#) to plan your journey.

By train:

The nearest stations are Durham and Bishop Auckland. From either station, take a bus towards Spennymoor town centre.

ENTRANCE TO PARK**



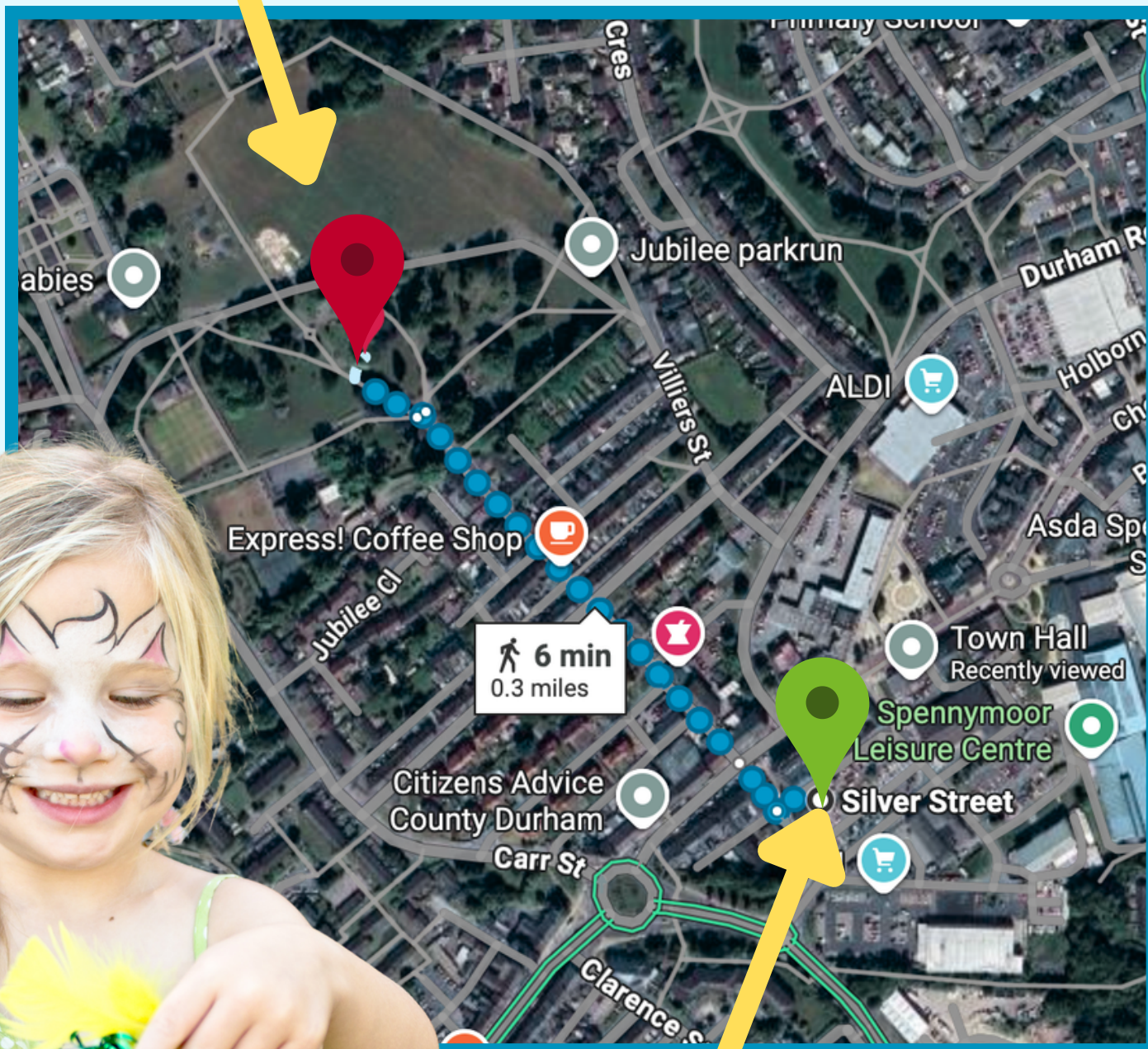
**GREENWAYS ESTATE

FREE CAR PARK

Parking:

There is limited parking available at the event site.

We recommend you use the **free car park** behind Spennymoor Town Hall and walk to the park.

The post code for the car park is **DL16 6DG**.

You can see the walking route marked on the map.

This helps us avoid congestion and keeps things running smoothly for all visitors.

Drop-Off Point:

If you can't walk from the town centre or find a parking space nearby, there are several entrances to the park you can be dropped off at, including the Dundas Street entrance marked on the map.

Your driver can drop you off here, then go and park in the car park.
